All students who want to receive dual college credit for the honors courses above <u>must be</u> <u>presently enrolled in the Pacifica class for this year, and then register with Colorado Christian University in their corresponding class before the deadlines below in order to receive dual credit.</u>

The registration process requires filling out a form and paying a fee.* This fee is nominal relative to the actual cost of the class for college students. It is therefore highly recommended that students take advantage of this dual credit opportunity in order to bolster their college application resumes, as well as save money and time once they get to college.

*A grade of C or above in the applicable Pacifica Course is required to receive dual credit from CCU.
