Engineering Design and Problem Solving (ES 301)

All students who wish to receive dual college credit for the honors courses above must register with University of Texas Austin in order to receive dual credit. The registration process requires filling out a form, submitting a portfolio of materials, and paying a fee. The fee is nominal relative to the actual cost of the class for college students. It is therefore highly recommended that students take advantage of this dual enrollment opportunity in order to bolster their college application resumes, as well as save time and money once you get to college.

Completing the above steps steps *does not guarantee* acceptance into the dual enrollment program. Students' portfolio work must show sufficient understanding and ability, after which UT Austin will inform you of the decision. The approximate dates for these decisions are below, exact dates forthcoming from UT Austin. Dual credit will then be awarded by UT Austin based on extra assignments which students will be assigned, complete, and submit entirely through UT Austin's website (see note below). The class fee is only paid if the student is accepted. There is no application fee.

Important Note: Enrollment in Honors/DE Engineering Design and Analysis at Pacifica is dependent on students enrollment in the UT Austin program. Students who do not wish to participate in the UT Austin program, or for any reason are not accepted, will be moved to the non-Honors section of Engineering Design and Analysis.
